At Tedder School, we believe that homework should support and consolidate key areas of the curriculum and learning in the classroom. Homework will focus entirely on areas that we feel have the greatest impact on the children's progress: reading and times tables. Furthermore, it supports children to take responsibility for their learning and develop independent learning skills. In addition, we recognise that homework provides a valuable opportunity for parents to engage in and support their children's learning.

We would be grateful if parents could provide a quiet, suitable place for their children to do their homework and encourage good homework habits. If children persistently neglect to do homework, parents will be informed by Class Teachers. This is a guide showing approximately the amount of homework set for different year groups. Class teachers will advise parents of the homework set.

Reception	Phonic work (approx. 5 minutes per day)
Years 1 and 2	10 minutes per day
Years 3 and 4	10 -15 minutes per day
Years 5 and 6	20 - 30 minutes per day

Class 1 Homework



Reception Children

Phonics – Children will be sent home the phonics sounds they have been learning in school. Parents are encouraged to help children learn their sounds on sight and how to write each one. These should be quickly revised at home.

Class 1 Homework

Reading – Children are expected to read at home three times a week and books will be changed on Monday.

Year 1

Maths – 20 minutes will be set on NumBots every Wednesday to be completed by the following Monday.

Reading – Children must read at home three times a week and books will be changed on Monday.

Class 2 Homework

Year 1 and 2

Maths – 20 minutes will be set on NumBots (Year 1) or TT Rock Stars (Year 2) every Friday to be completed by the following Friday.

Reading – Children must read at home three times a week and their reading diary signed as evidence, once again this is to be completed Friday to Friday and books will be changed on Monday if finished.

Class 3 Homework

Homework will focus entirely on areas that we feel have the greatest impact on the children's progress: reading and times tables. They will need to complete the following each week:

- **Read** for 10-15 minutes (preferably daily, but at least three times a week). They should record their page number in their reading record and please can this be signed by an adult to confirm that it has been completed.
- Complete times tables homework set on **TTRockstars**. This does not have to be completed in one go and can be split into lots of short sessions.

Reading:

Children will have a reading book that is recommended for their year group; unless they need additional support with reading. You will be informed if this is the case.

Children will also have the opportunity to bring home a reading for pleasure book that they have picked from a range of high quality texts. This is for reading independently and is to inspire a love of reading.

TTRockstars:

Good **times tables** knowledge is vital in Key Stage Two in order to be successful with the maths curriculum. Children are therefore expected to practise their times tables regularly each week. They all have a TTRockstars account to support this and login details can be found at the front of their homework diary. Year 4 children will also be completing a statutory check in Summer Term; information about this will be sent closer to the time.



The children are expected to complete all homework tasks and are responsible for completing it in on time.

Class 4 Homework

Year 5/6 is an important time for the children as they prepare for the transition to secondary school. It is important for them to develop good homework routines so that they are better prepared for the increased demands in Year 7.

Homework will focus entirely on areas that we feel have the greatest impact on the children's progress: reading and times tables. They will need to complete the following each week:

- **Read** for 10-15 minutes (preferably daily, but at least three times a week). They should record their page number in their blue homework diary and please can this be signed by an adult to confirm that it has been completed.
- Complete times tables homework set on **TTRockstars**. This does not have to be completed in one go and can be split into lots of short sessions.

Reading:

There are a wide range of high quality books in our class library and all children are expected to have a reading book and change this regularly. They are welcome to bring in a suitable book from home as long as it is brought to school each day and provides an appropriate level of challenge.

TTRockstars:

Good **times tables** knowledge is vital in upper Key Stage Two in order to be successful with the demanding maths curriculum. Children are therefore expected to practise their times tables regularly each week. They all have a TTRockstars account to support this and login details can be found at the front of their homework diary.

The children are expected to complete all homework tasks and are responsible for handing it in on time. If homework tasks are not handed in, children may be asked to complete them at break time. If this is a regular occurrence, you will be informed via email.
